CENT PERCENT COMPUTER LITERACY CAMPAIGN

Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) Regional Centre Vatakara embarked upon a new path with the objective of imparting computer literacy to the masses through its Computer Literacy Programme (CLP) at nominal cost. The programme duration for each batch shall be one month. The cardinal idea behind the effort is to make Vatakara thaluk 100% computer literate, with in a limited time frame. As an initial step in this direction, the Regional Centre plans to impart computer literacy to the eligible candidates in Chorode panchayath in a period of two years. It is estimated that nearly 12000 persons will benefit from the programme at Chorode alone.

The massive endeavour was flagged by the Hon'ble MP of Vatakara Sh.Mullappally Ramachandran at a glittering ceremony at Vatakara Cooperative College on 10/1/2018. While inaugurating the ambitious project the Hon'ble MP emphasised upon the immense importance of attaining Computer Literacy. He stated that a community without computer literacy is as good as being illiterate in the modern world. He stated that in India only 20% of the population alone is computer literate at present. In Kerala the percentage is 40%. He congratulated IGNOU Regional centre Vatakara for taking up this novel initiative and wished that the effort would turn out to be a path breaker in community development. He also announced that computers worth Rs.3 Lakhs would be made available to the Regional Centre to kick start the programme.

The inaugural meeting also witnessed speeches by Sh. C. Vatsalan, President of Vatakara Cooperative Society, Dr.M.Rajesh, Regional Director, IGNOU Regional Centre Vatakara, Dr.Prameela.O, Assistant Regional Director, IGNOU Regional Centre Vatakara, Dr.SK.Zareena, Assistant Regional Director, IGNOU Regional Centre Vatakara, Sh. Praveen Kumara, Assistant Registrar, IGNOU Regional Centre Vatakara, Dr.Vijayalakshmi, Coordinator, IGNOU Study Centre Vatakara, Dr. Ammukutty, Assistant Coordinator, IGNOU Study Centre Vatakara and Sh. Anil Kumar, Principal, Vatakara Cooperative Arts and Science College.

A groundswell of interest was witnessed among the public to join the programme and nearly 50 candidates have already joined in the first batch.

Iringal Craft Village- the pride of Vatakara M.Rajesh

I am quite new to Vatakara. Yet even during my initial stay at this scenic town, I was instinctively drawn towards the craft village located at the outskirts of Vatakara named Iringal. The location is indeed ideal for the establishment of a craft village. Located at a stone's throw from the highway to Kannur, it is easily accessible to the tourists. But what surprises me is the fact that not many have heard about it outside Kozhikode district. Notwithstanding this about 2 lakh visitors throng the place during the annual crafts mela.

The striking feature of the place is the artificially created lake at the centre of the craft village. It is on record that a barren quarry was refurbished to the present form. The highlight of this lake is the boating facilities that it offers. One can spend quality time peddle boating at this location at reasonable costs when compared to other locations of a similar nature.





At any point in time, nearly 50-60 artisan have their shops open to cater to the needs of customers. Not all items are priced reasonably. Some of it is beyond the purchasing power of an average buyer. But the spectacle of these pristinely showcased products is worth absorbing. During the annual crafts mela usually held in the first week of January, a large number of artisans from different parts of the world throng Iringal to showcase their wares to probing eyes, not always in the quest of finding a customer. A smile in approval and encouragement is often the much needed panacea to revive a dying art. We were in time to spot a group of artisans from Uganda, who had put up their wares at the location.





I had the opportunity to speak to Mr. Rajesh, the General Manager of the consortia that run the craft village. He was candid in stating that the crafts village is not a profit making venture. They in fact had to fund most of the artisans to keep the show going. We enquired whether IGNOU could chip in to contribute to the educational progress of the artisans. The reply was on expected lines. For persons to whom the next meal is a big question, education is a luxury, however cheap and relevant it may be! However, he assures us that no effort would be spared to introduce IGNOU and its progressive features to the artisans.

VATAKARA RIDERS- SCALING NEW HEIGHTS B.PRAVEEN KUMARA

Vatakara Riders is an association of cycling enthusiasts who reside in Vatakara. The principal aim of Vatakara Riders is to create awareness among the public about the benefits of Cycling.

The formation of Vatakara Riders was initiated by a group of people who regularly travel from Vatakara Railway Station to different locations for their official purposes. Traffic congestion and parking of the vehicle were constraints they encountered in the morning and evening. There came an idea of using bicycle instead of car or motorcycle which can reduce the traffic as well as parking space. These likeminded cycling enthusiasts started serious discussions and it lead to the formation of the club 'Vatakara Riders'.

The Cycling Club was formed in May, 2017 and the following office bearers were unanimously elected: Shri. Prasoon CB as President, Shri. Dinesh K as Secretary and Shri. Sibi P as Treasurer. Shri. Abraham Nedumparambil, Super Randonneur (SR) and the first person to become SR in the Malabar Region inaugurated the Vatakara Riders. He is the ride representative of Audax India Randanneurs (AIR).





The following benefits accrue as a result of cycling:

- 1. Health: Latest research findings reveal that regular cycling is considered as the best exercise to reduce cardiac and other life style diseases.
- 2. Environment: Less fossil fuel consumption which reduces environment pollution.
- 3. Traffic: Travelling in bicycle can definitely reduce traffic congestion.
- 4. Regular rides: Regular group rides to places of scenic beauty promotes the habit of cycling as well enables the members to enjoy nature.
- 5. Sporting: Cycling is a widely accepted sporting event and most of the active members had successfully finished in 200 kms and 300 kms BRM conducted by the Audax India Randanneurs (AIR).
